SCHOOL MINISTRY ACTIVITIES



We thank God for the more school that the Lord has led us to, making a total of 8 schools with about 900 school pupils being reached with the Gospel on weekly basis. We hoping that this new academic year which was started this September the Lord will grant us access to more schools.

We are also praying for approval as we plan to write to the Ghana Education Service for permission into many school that we do not have permission.

PRISON MINISTRY ACTIVITIES

We are glad that the Lord has given us the permit to enter the Ghana prisons to interact with and have services with inmates on monthly basis. We are currently working in 4 prisons in the Northern Region of Ghana. Through our service the inmates have the opportunity to hear the good news.

Pray that these inmates and officers will respond to the gospel and be converted, which will lead to final transformation of these inmates. Each time I travel to visit these prisons I receive a lot of requests in terms of food, clothes, and many other things. We are relying on your prayers and support to enable us travel every month to these prisons. I normally travel several hours and kilometers to get to these prisons.

However, many of the children in the club are in great need of educational materials for the new academy year. These items include: school bags, books, shoes, pens, pencils, and uniforms. We are trusting that the Lord will provide for us to meet these needs of the children.

We are also praying to organize a Christmas party for the children at the club because in the village they do not celebrate Christmas, this will help spread the love of Christ to the children. We covet your continual prayer and financial support to meet these needs.
